Woodlot Assessment Report	This is an introductory service provided to all woodlot owners on Cape Breton. It includes a series f maps and reports about your woodlot as well as a meeting with a forest professional to talk about options for your woodlot. The maps and reports are based on computer mapping, not someone walking your woodlot.	Any woodlot owner on Cape Breton	\$0	\$0
Forest Management Plan	This is a complete management plan for your woodlot based on a forest professional walking the entire property. It includes information on what was found, prescribed treatments, maps and photographs of the woodlot.		\$1200	\$500 (this cost can be recovered by the woodlot owner if wood is delivered to Port Hawkesbury Paper or Nova Scotia Power must be renewed in 10 years)
FSC® Certification	This is an optional third party verification that any work completed on your woodlot meets the international Forest Stewardship Council (FSC*) standard.	Must be a member with a management plan completed.	NA	\$0
Contractor Supervision	An inspection is carried out on any contractor working on your woodlot. The completed report is made available to the woodlot owner, contractor, and any member interested in hiring that contractor in the future.	Currently only offered to CBPP members.	NA	\$0
Drone Imagery	Your property will have ortho-rectified aerial imagery completed for it. This provides up to date information about the property, and is tremendously useful for all future activities.	To qualify for discount pricing the imagery must be done prior to a management plan being completed.	\$7/hectare	\$3.50/hectare
Layout	An independent forest professional will flag areas on your woodlot to be harvested. In this way you can be sure that the area harvested is clearly understood prior to work beginning.		\$40/ha	\$20/ha (this cost can be recovered by the woodlot owner if wood is delivered to Port Hawkesbury Paper or Nova Scotia Power)
Silviculture Funding	CBPP can arrange for silviculture on member woodlots.	As of June 2017 a management plan must be in place to receive silviculture funding.	NA	\$0
Woodlot Monitoring	CBPP will provide an annual visit and report for woodlot owners unable to regularly visit their property.	This program will begin in 2017.	\$500/year	\$250/year
